**** DOGS IN PARKED CARS ON HOT DAYS ****

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather, and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help you whilst at this event:

- The Vehicle should be fully ventilated as possible, and fresh water should be available to drink
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free-flowing air around the dog
- Whilst at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle in full sunlight.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade, a large umbrella, and always have water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated
- Avoid your dog taking part in any unnecessary exertion or from standing in full sunlight for any length of time.
- Remember, if you feel hot, your dog is likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

Warning: If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary, without liability for any damage caused

Anyone who is entered in a Kennel Club licensed event should take all responsible steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met. Breach of Kennel Club regulations in this respect may be referred to the general committee for disciplinary action.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that Show Societies have the right, under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
